MAIN SUBJECTS

- *Medieval Philosophy*: one area of research is the relationship between Logic and Metaphysics in the 14th century (William of Ockham, John Buridan, Paul of Venice).
- Arabic and Islamic Philosophy: I read many important sources of Islamic medieval philosophy under the direction of Professor Amos Bertolacci. These included works by Al-Kindi, Avicenna, and Fakhr al-Dīn al-Rāzī. I also studied the transmission of Aristotelian philosophy in Baghdad during the 10th century and Averroes's Commentary on Aristotle's Metaphysics.
- Ancient and Late-Antiquity Philosophy: I studied the thought of eminent Neoplatonic philosophers, like Plotinus, Proclus, Damascius, and of Greek Aristotelian Commentators, like Alexander of Aphrodisia, Simplicius and Ammonius, under the direction of Professor C. D'Ancona and Doctor C. Luna. I studied Latin Palaeography under the direction of Doctor Luna.

• Logic and History of Logic: I also studied important topics in the philosophy of Mathematics and Logic, like Gödel's Incompleteness Theorem and Hilbert's Axiomatic Theory, and the relationship between Logic and Metaphysics in Leibniz's and Gödel's accounts of the ontological argument. The relationship between Logic and Metaphysics in the Middle Ages is one of the main topics; from a methodological point of view I adopted Peter Geach's works as a fundamental starting point of my research (Form and Existence, The doctrine of Distribution, Reference and Generality, Logic Matters, Distribution and Suppositio).
