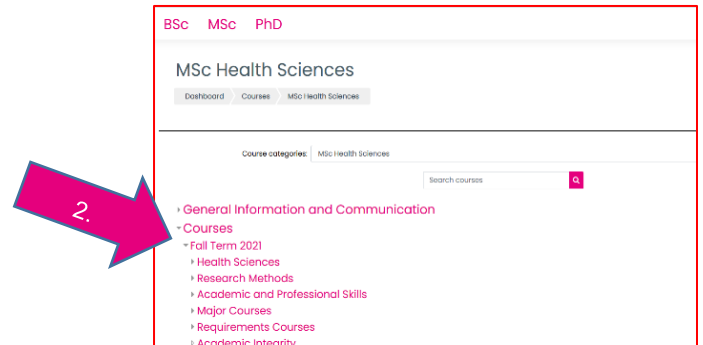
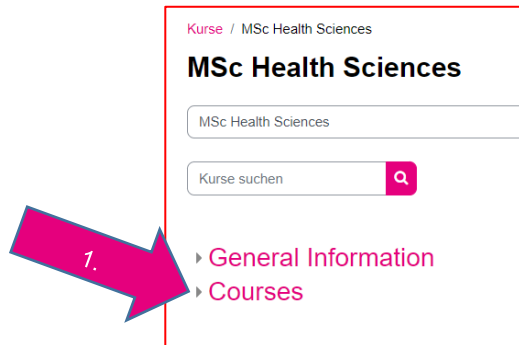

Students will also be informed about the major choice, the internships, and study opportunities after the first semester.

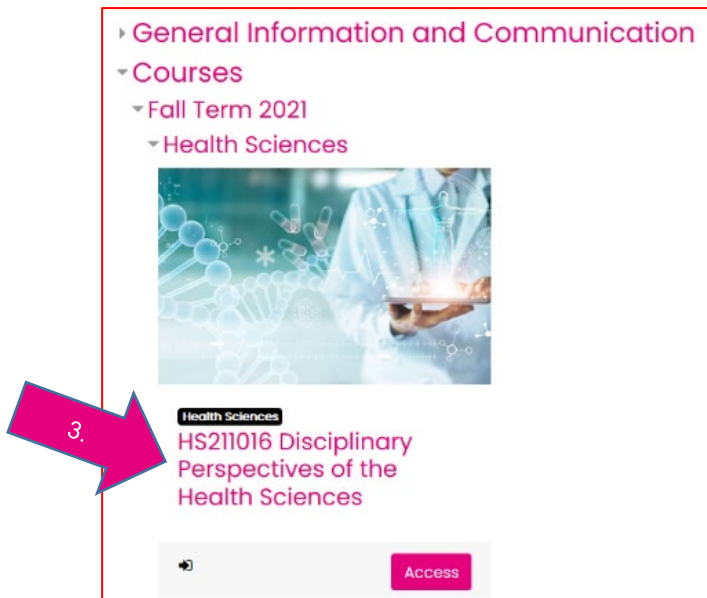
